***IV. Matt. 9:38, Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."***

**A. Father, I ask that You send laborers to them. I release laborers to cross their path and sow Your seed by speaking Your word to them.**

***V. John 14.26, But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.***

**A. Holy Spirit, I believe you are bringing back truths to their remembrance, Scriptures and things that you have spoken to them in the past. Show them, I pray, how much the Father loves them.**

***VI. John 20:23, Whosoever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whosoever sins ye retain, they are retained.***

**A. Father, I also remit their sins and believe that their hardness of heart is broken, in Jesus name. I thank you for the seed of your word being sown in their life. I pray it will be watered and nourished so that it can bring forth the full abundant harvest of their salvation - spirit, soul, and body.**
