## **WHAT WE BELIEVE**

### **THE HOLY SCRIPTURES**

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness (2 Tim. 3:16)

### **THE ETERNAL GODHEAD**

For there are three that bear witness in heaven: the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one (1 Jn. 5:7). Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit (Mt. 28:19).

### **THE CREATION OF MAN**

So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them (Gen. 1:27).

### **THE FALL OF MAN**

Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned (Rom. 5:12). For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Rom. 3:23).

### **THE WORD MADE FLESH**

Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign; Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel (Is. 7:14). And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth (Jn. 1:14).

### **THE FINISHED WORK OF CHRIST**

But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God (Heb. 10:12). For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Cor. 5:21). Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness – by whose stripes you were healed (1 Pet. 2:24). Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases (Psalm 103:3).

## **SALVATION**

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life (Jn. 3:16). That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation (Rom. 10:9,10). For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast (Eph. 2:8,9).

## **THE NEW COVENANT**

This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them...and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more (Heb. 10:16,17).

## **THE NEW BIRTH**

Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God (Jn. 3:3)". Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new (2 Cor. 5:17).

## **THE DOCTRINE OF BAPTISMS**

For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body...and have all been made to drink into one Spirit (1 Cor. 12:13). He (Jesus) will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire (Mt. 3:11). But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you: and you shall be witnesses to Me...to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8). (Water baptism is an outward testimony of an inward work, see Acts 10:44-48).

## **THE LORD'S SUPPER**

And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you (Luke 22:19,20)."

## **THE BODY OF CHRIST**

Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of

tongues (1 Cor. 12:27,28). There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord, and there are diversities of workings, but is the same God who works all in all (1 Cor. 12:4-6). And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together...but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching (Heb. 10:24,25).

### **OUR TWO-FOLD MANDATE**

And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved: but he who does not believe will be condemned (Mk. 16:15,16).” Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations...teaching them to observe all things I have commanded you (Mt. 28:19,20).

### **MIRACLES, SIGNS, AND WONDERS**

And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God (1 Cor. 2:4,5).

### **THE INVISIBLE KINGDOM**

Those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ (Rom. 5:17).

### **THE RETURN OF JESUS CHRIST**

This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven (Acts 1:11). For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord (1 Thess. 4:16,17).

### **THE RESTORATION OF THE KINGDOM TO ISRAEL**

Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, “Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel (Acts 1:6)?” For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. But each in his own order; Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ’s at His coming. Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign till

He has put all enemies under His feet (1 Cor. 15:22-25). Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first, resurrection. Over such the second, death, has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years (Rev. 20:6).

### **ETERNAL JUDGMENT**

And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment... (Heb. 9:27). And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting contempt (Dan. 12:2). Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire (Rev. 20:14,15).

### **THE NEW HEAVENS AND NEW EARTH**

Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away (Rev. 21:1). Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new (Rev. 21:5)." And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him...And they shall reign forever and ever (Rev. 22:3,5).
